Thanks to the collaboration of two Boston area businesses, Dress for Success Boston will have a new, improved storage area at its 989 Commonwealth Ave. Dress for Success Boston is a nonprofit whose mission is to promote the economic independence of disadvantaged women by providing professional attire, a network of support and the career development tools to help women thrive in work and in life.

Heidi Solomon, principal of **POSH Consulting** of Brookline, is donating its firm's organizational and strategic planning services to help Dress for Success improve the processing of weekly donations, thereby allowing staff more time and energy to focus on assisting clients. In talking with the team at Dress for Success Boston, Solomon learned that they are in desperate need of efficient and practical storage within their building. She contacted Brian McSharry, principal of Closet and Storage Concepts, and after devising a sorting and processing system together, Brian drafted the designs. He also agreed to donate the time and materials to build the shelving system in the back area of the building. The cost of building the closets is \$4,300.
